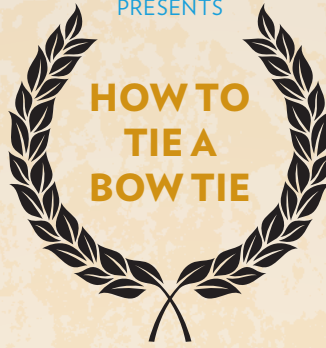

HOW TO TIE A BOW TIE

1.



Drape the tie around your neck with one end approximately one-inch longer than the other.

2.



Cross the longer end over the shorter end.

3.



Pull the longer end up through the loop, underneath the shorter end.

4.



Double-up the short end.

5.



Drop the long end over the front of the loop and doubled-up short end.

6.



Double-up the long end.

7.



Pull the doubled-up long end behind the short end and poke through knot.

8.



Adjust the two ends evenly and tighten.
